## From the West

Take the A27 heading towards Polegate. Once you reach the large traffic light T junction, turn right onto the A2270. Follow this road through 2 sets of traffic lights and over a large roundabout taking the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit to continue on the A2270 Willingdon Road, continue through 2 further sets of traffic lights. Follow the road down the hill and Eastbourne town centre is in front of you. The Road turns into the A259 and at 3<sup>rd</sup> traffic lights turn left onto The Avenue. Take the fifth road on the left onto St Annes Road and the clinic is half way up this road on the right-hand side.

## From the East

Follow the A259 towards Eastbourne, at the Pevensey Bay roundabout take the second exit then left turn staying on the A259. Head towards Pevensey Bay and continue through the traffic lights and right-hand bend to continue on the A259, Eastbourne Road. Continue on the A259 over 2 roundabouts and at the 3<sup>rd</sup> roundabout (Langney roundabout) stay in the right lane and take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit onto St. Anthony's Avenue. Keep in the left lane to cross the next roundabout at Lottbridge Drove and stay on the A259 onto Seaside. Keep on this road until there is a right turn onto Cavendish Place, continue on this road that turns into Upper Avenue. At the roundabout take the first roundabout exit that continues into The Avenue. Turn right after the island onto St Annes Road and the clinic is half way up on the right-hand side.

## From the North

Head towards Eastbourne via A267 (Horam) or A22 (Uckfield) both join the Boship roundabout where you continue on the A22 Hailsham bypass towards Eastbourne. Continue over 2 roundabouts until you reach the large Cop Hall roundabout, take 3<sup>rd</sup> exit onto the A27 and continue through the traffic lights onto A2270 Eastbourne Road. Follow this road through a set of traffic lights and over a large roundabout taking the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit to continue on the A2270 Willingdon Road, continue through 2 further sets of traffic lights. Follow the road down the hill and Eastbourne town centre is in front of you. The Road turns into the A259 and at 3<sup>rd</sup> traffic lights turn left onto The Avenue. Take the fifth road on the left onto St Annes Road and the clinic is half way up this road on the right-hand side.

## **Parking**

There is a designated client car park for the Coast Clinic, St. Annes Vets and Vets Now clinics on the right-hand side of the road one house before the clinic.

Road parking directly outside and adjacent to the clinic is in bays with a maximum stay of 1 hour. Other on road parking is not restricted.
